# **NARA**

Todai-ji Temple - is one of Japan's most famous and historically significant temples and a landmark of Nara. The temple is a listed UNESCO World Heritage Site as "Historic Monuments of Ancient Nara", together with seven other sites including temples, shrines and places .the Big Buddha Hall is the world's largest wooden building, despite the fact that the present reconstruction of 1692 is only two thirds of the original temple hall's size.

### **KYOTO**

- Kiyomizu Temple The temple is renowned for its construction which uses no nails to support the elaborate wooden structure of the main hall. And with a quaint old lane lined with pottery shops lead up to this famous temple. Nishijin Textile Centre (Kimono Show) Here you can find a great variety of works created in the Nishijin Spirit, like Kimono & Kimono Sashes. And you could enjoy a Kimono show in the centre.
- Ninenzaka Path, Sannenzaka Path This is a stone road on a hillside, the Shinto of Kiyomizu Temple. Souvenir shops, pottery shops and restaurants line the roadside. Nearby are Yasaka Shrine, Maruyama Park, Kodaiji Temple, and Hokanji Temple. According to the Cultural Properties Protection Act, it is listed as an important traditional building preservation area.
- Fushimi Inari Shrine is the most important of several thousands of shrines dedicated to Inari. famous for its thousands (over 10,000) of closely-spaced orange torii gates that wind over the hills of Inariyama beyond the entrance to the shrine. Inari was seen as the patron of business, and merchants and manufacturers have traditionally worshipped Inari.

#### **OSAKA**

- Osaka Castle it is one of Japan's most famous castles.
- Universal Studios Japan (USJ) Was the first theme park under the Universal Studios Brand to be build in Asia, currently has eight sections; Hollywood, New York, San Francisco, Jurassic Park, Water world, Amity Village, Universal Wonderland and the Wizarding World of Harry Potter.
- Shinsaibashi Shopping Arcade A largest shopping area covered shopping street, liveliest and it lines with an interesting shop. There are a lot of boutiques and specialty stores, including Japanese cuisine, and can enjoy the different flavors of various countries in the world.
- Kuromon Market The traditional market in Osaka's Namba district has long and narrow passages lined with vendors selling fresh fish and agricultural products. Visitors to the market can carefully select products while following the cries of fishmongers.

# 奈良

◆ **东大寺** - 被列入《世界遗产名录》的东大寺是公元728年遵照重视佛教的圣武天皇 圣旨建造的。东大寺是全国68所国分寺的总寺院,据说是因为建在首都平城京以东 ,所以被称作"东大寺"。正面宽度57米、深50米的世界最大的木造建筑东大寺大佛殿内,放置着高15米以上的佛像。

## 京都

- ◆ 清水寺 历史悠久的寺庙,整座建筑完全不用铁打钉琐。沿途坡道两旁 是日式古老 建筑及商店,摆满了各种各式的日本手工艺品,陶瓷,日本 娃娃等,不胜枚举。
- ◆ **二年城,三年城** 这是一条山坡上的石板路,即清水寺的神道。纪念品店,陶器店和餐厅林立路旁。附近有八坂神社、圆山公园、高台寺、法观寺。根据文化财保护法,被列为重要传统的建造物群保存地区。
- ◆ 伏见稻荷神社 伏见稻荷大社每年都有大量的香客前来神社祭拜求取农作丰收,生意兴隆,交通安全。另外起源于江户时代的习俗,前来此地许愿的人们往往会捐款在神社境内竖立一座鸟居来表达对神明的敬意,使其神社的范围内竖有数量惊人的大小鸟居,而以「千本鸟居」之名闻名日本全国乃至于海外。

#### 大阪

- ◆ 大阪城堡 是大阪的象征,它包括十三处被日本政府立为重要文化遗产的建筑
- ◆ **日本环球影城** 日本国民和外国旅行者心目中的超人气主题乐园,便是一座电影主题绿了场,分为纽约区、好莱坞区、旧金山区、哈利·波特的魔法世界、水世界、亲善村、环球奇境、侏罗纪公园八个区城。
- ◆ 心斋桥商店街 大阪最大的购物区,也是日本最长的天缝式购物街,集中了许多精品屋和专卖店还有很多饮食店。
- ◆ 黑门市场 大阪难波区的传统市场,狭长的通道两边排满了售卖新鲜渔获与农产品的摊贩。逛市场的游客可以随着鱼贩的叫卖声,精心挑选产品。泡菜的强烈气味以及丰富的海产、肉类与农产品,随时都在刺激您的感官。
