ISTANBUL

- **Blue Mosque** - Also known as Sultan Ahmed Mosque is a historical mosque in Istanbul. The mosque is known as the Blue Mosque because of blue tiles surrounding the walls of interior design.
- **Hippodrome Square** - Where horse carriage and gladiator fights took place during the Byzantine Empire. It is decorated today with an Egyptian Column, Serpentine Column and Ibrahim Pasa Palace.
- **Hagia Sophia** - After the Ottoman Empire captured Constantinople in 1453, it was converted into a mosque. Today, it stands as a powerful symbol of both Eastern Roman and Ottoman taste for art and architecture.
- **Topkapi Palace** - Have large collections of porcelain, robes, weapons, Ottoman miniatures, Islamic calligraphic manuscripts as well as other Ottoman treasures and jewellery. Visit the Palace Treasury that holds a fascinating collection of the world's most famous and spectacular jewels including the famous Topkapi Dagger.
- **Basilica Cistern** - Is the largest underground cistern of Eastern Roman times. Also known by its Turkish name Yerebatan Sarnıcı, it is one of the major tourist attractions of modern Istanbul.
- **Beylerbeyi Palace** - Is located in the Beylerbeyi neighbourhood of Üsküdar district in Istanbul, Turkey, at the Asian side of the Bosphorus. An imperial Ottoman summer residence built between 1861 and 1865.
- **Maiden's Tower** - Is a unique architectural masterpiece that combines history and style. It is a witness to the changing times and cultures of Istanbul. It is a place where you can admire the beauty and craftsmanship of its design, while learning about its fascinating stories.

- ✓ Topkapi Palace is an architectural marvel that celebrates the rich culture and history of the Ottoman Empire
- ✓ Basilica Cistern is the largest of several hundred ancient cisterns that lie beneath the city of Istanbul
- ✓ Enjoy Bosphorus Cruise Trip on the 32 km (20-mile) long strait which joins the Sea of Marmara to the south with the Black Sea to the north of Istanbul
- ✓ Grand Bazaar in Istanbul is one of the largest and oldest markets in the world
- ✓ Beylerbeyi Palace the sumptuous design and wonderful location of this beautiful building are a treat
- ✓ Maiden's Tower is more than just a tower on the sea; it is a symbol of Istanbul's rich and diverse history and culture
- ✓ Ortaköy Mosque is symbolic of the district of Ortaköy and is often photographed, as it has a distinctive view of the Bosphorus Strait of Istanbul and the Bosphorus Bridge

ISTANBUL

- **Ortaköy Mosque** - Is a mosque situated at the waterside of the Ortaköy pier square. It was commissioned by the Ottoman Sultan Abdülmecid and its construction was completed around 1854 or 1856. This structure is symbolic of the district of Ortaköy and is often photographed, as it has a distinctive view of the Bosphorus Strait of Istanbul and the Bosphorus Bridge.
- **Galata Tower** - Officially the Galata Tower, is an old Genoese tower in the Galata part of the Beyoğlu district of Istanbul, Türkiye. Built as a watchtower at the highest point of the (lost) Walls of Galata, the tower is now an exhibition space and museum, and a symbol of Beyoğlu and Istanbul.
