TOURIST ATTRACTIONS:

OSAKA

- ◆ **Osaka Castle Park** - Built in the 16th century, Osaka Castle is one of Japan's most iconic historical landmarks. The spacious park is surrounded by moats, beautiful gardens, and traditional architecture, creating a peaceful atmosphere in every season. Visitors can stroll around the castle grounds, take photos, and experience the rich history of Toyotomi Hideyoshi, one of Japan's most famous samurai leaders.
- ◆ **Dotonbori** - Osaka's most famous entertainment and shopping district. Known for its bright neon lights, street food such as Takoyaki, and the iconic Glico Running Man sign, the area is lively during the day and even more vibrant at night. It is the perfect place to experience Osaka's energetic city life.
- ◆ **Tsutenkaku Tower & Shinsekai** - Tsutenkaku is a symbol of old Osaka, surrounded by the retro-style Shinsekai neighbourhood. While the tower can be admired from the outside for photos, the streets below preserve the nostalgic atmosphere of the Showa era. Walking through the area, visitors can enjoy traditional snacks, take photos, and experience the local lifestyle of Osaka's old downtown.

KYOTO

- ◆ **Arashiyama Togetsukyo Bridge** - The Togetsukyo Bridge spans the Katsura River and is the most famous landmark in Arashiyama. Surrounded by mountains, it offers beautiful scenery throughout the year — cherry blossoms in spring, lush greenery in summer, colourful autumn leaves, and snow-covered views in winter. Visitors can walk across the bridge and enjoy Kyoto's peaceful natural beauty.
- ◆ **Kiyomizu-dera Temple** - Founded in 778, Kiyomizu-dera is a UNESCO World Heritage Site and one of Kyoto's most famous temples. Its wooden stage, built without using a single nail, stands dramatically above the hillside. From here, visitors can enjoy panoramic views of Kyoto. The surrounding old streets and teahouses add to the traditional atmosphere, making it a perfect place for sightseeing and photography.
- ◆ **Gion** - Kyoto's traditional entertainment district and the birthplace of geisha culture. The area is filled with wooden townhouses, tea houses, and charming narrow streets. In the evening, visitors may even spot geiko and maiko in traditional kimono walking through the streets, offering a truly authentic Kyoto experience.

NARA

- ◆ **Nara Park** - One of Japan's oldest parks, famous for its freely roaming deer. These friendly and gentle deer are known to bow for food, creating a unique and adorable experience for visitors. The park's open lawns and walking paths make it a perfect place for relaxing, taking photos, and enjoying nature.
- ◆ **Todaiji Temple** - Todaiji is a UNESCO World Heritage Site and home to the Great Buddha (Daibutsu), one of the largest bronze Buddha statues in Japan. Inside the massive Great Buddha Hall, visitors can admire the impressive statue and feel the deep spiritual and historical atmosphere. It is one of Nara's most important and iconic cultural landmarks.

观光景点：

大阪

- ◆ **大阪城公园** - 建于16世纪，也是日本最著名的历史地标之一。公园内宽阔的护城河、精美的庭园与历史建筑相映成趣，四季景色各异，春天樱花盛开时尤为迷人。游客可在外围散步、拍照留念，静静感受丰臣秀吉的历史气息与古都风韵。
- ◆ **道顿堀** - 大阪最有名的地标街区，霓虹夜景、章鱼烧、格力高跑男广告牌最出圈。白天热闹、夜晚更精彩。
- ◆ **通天阁 + 新世界街区** - 昭和时代风情的地标建筑，塔身可远观拍照，街区保留大阪市井文化。漫步其中，可以感受复古气息、尝试传统小吃，拍照留念，也能体验大阪老城区独有的生活风情。

京都

- ◆ **岚山渡月桥** - 横跨桂川的木制桥梁，是岚山最具代表性的景观。桥两侧群山环绕，四季景色各异：春天樱花、夏日绿意、秋天红叶、冬日白雪。游客可漫步桥上拍照，感受京都的自然宁静与诗意风光。
- ◆ **清水寺** - 始建于778年，世界文化遗产，京都必访古寺之一。寺庙最著名的清水舞台完全由木结构搭建，没有使用一颗铁钉，悬空而立，工艺精妙。登上舞台可俯瞰京都全景，周边古街与茶屋增添浓厚历史氛围，是拍照与体验日本传统文化的绝佳之地。
- ◆ **祇园** - 京都传统街区，也是艺伎文化发源地。漫步在古色古香的街道上，木造建筑和传统茶屋错落其间。傍晚时分偶尔可看到身着和服的艺伎匆匆而过，是拍照与感受古都氛围的绝佳体验。

奈良

- ◆ **奈良公园** - 拥有悠闲漫步的小径与自由活动的梅花鹿，是日本最古老的城市公园之一。小鹿温顺且聪明，会向游客“鞠躬”讨食，非常可爱，是拍照留念和亲近自然的最佳体验。
- ◆ **东大寺** - 世界文化遗产，日本最大佛堂所在地，以巨大的大佛 (DAIBUTSU) 闻名。进入大佛殿可近距离感受历史与宗教的庄严气息，外观宏伟，是奈良必打卡的文化景点。
