

TOURIST ATTRACTIONS:

TOKYO

- Sensoji (Asakusa Kanon Temple) The temple is dedicated to the god of mercy, Kanon. And is famous for its Kaminari-mon or Thunder Gate. And you could walk along Nakamise Shopping Arcade, is bustling with people buying traditional Japanese snacks, which you could see many snack stalls demonstrate how they make it and then sell it still piping hot.
- Shinjuku Kabuki-cho Is one of the 23 wards of Tokyo, but the name commonly refers just to the large entertainment, business and shopping area around Shinjuku Station. Handling more than two million passengers each day.

HAKONE

- Mount Fuji Mt. Fuji, rising above the clouds, is the symbol of Japan and has provided a spiritual basis for the Japanese since ancient times, with the height of 3776m high.
- Owakudani An area with active volcanic zone where sulphurous fumes, its "Black jewel eggs" cooked in the area's thermal heat sources, are a Hakone specially.
- Lake Ashi Pirate Ship Was formed in the caldera of Mount Hakone after the volcano's last eruption 3000 years ago. And the boat ride could enjoy dreams and romance while gazing upon the delights of Mt. Fuji.

KYOTO

• Kyoto Kiyomizu Temple - The temple is renowned for its construction which uses no nails to support the elaborate wooden structure of the main hall. And with a quaint old lane lined with pottery shops lead up to this famous temple. Nishijin Textile Centre (Kimono Show) - Here you can find a great variety of works created in the Nishijin Spirit, like Kimono & Kimono Sashes. And you could enjoy a Kimono show in the centre.

OSAKA

- Shinsaibashi Shopping Arcade It is said to be the longest in Japan. Once inside the arcade, approx. 600 stores; old-fashioned diners, delicatessen, knife shops of long tradition, a tea store established in 1868, tofu, croquettes, chinaware and kimono.
- ◆ Osaka Castle It is one of Japan's most famous castles.

NARA

▶ Todai-ji Temple - Is one of Japan's most famous and historically temples and a landmark of Nara. The temple is a listed UNESCO World Heritage Site as "Historic Monuments of Ancient Nara", together with seven other sites including temples, shrines and places .the Big Buddha Hall is the world's largest wooden building, despite the fact that the present reconstruction of 1692 is only two thirds of the original temple hall's size.

观光景点:

- ◆ **浅草雷门观音寺** 建于7世纪的佛庙,其象征物是风雷神门,上面挂着写有"雷门" 两个字的大红灯笼,这里每天都有前来参拜的观光客,终年熙熙攘攘。您也可在该寺 前的热闹街道"仲见世"购物,此处满布出售纪念品的小店及当地小吃的日式店铺。
- **新宿购物区** 东京都政府大楼、高楼大厦林立的事务所一条街。以购物、娱乐综合 设施为中心的新宿,被誉为不夜城的歌舞伎町为中心的日本少有的娱乐区。

箱根

- 富士山 富士山海拔3776米,是日本第一高峰。它气势雄伟,为其它山峰所不及, 呈圆锥形的山姿十分优美,常常被用来作为绘画和文学的创作题材,它作为日本的象 征,名扬全世界。
- ◆ 箱根大濔谷 为300年前火山爆发的火山口,每当起风时,带着硫磺味的浓烟弥漫 期 间时,形成特殊景观。登上山顶,有用火山温泉煮熟的「黑鸡蛋」,据日本人说吃-个可长寿7年。
- ◆ 芦之湖海盗船 乘海盗船游览背倚着富士山的芦之湖,湖山相映,不同的季节有不同 的景致和情趣。

清水寺 - 历史悠久的寺庙、整座建筑完全不用铁打钉琐。沿途坡道两旁 是日式古老 建筑及商店、摆满了各种各式的日本手工艺品、陶瓷、日本娃娃等、不胜枚举。

大阪

- 心斋桥购物街 大阪最大的购物区,也是日本最长的天缝式购物街,集中了许多精品 屋和专卖店还有很多饮食店,既有日本菜,也可以品尝到中国、韩国、亚洲、美洲和 欧洲等世界各个国家、各个地区不同的风味呢。
- 大阪城堡 是大阪的象征,它包括十三处被日本政府立为重要文化遗产的建筑。

东大寺 - 被列入《世界遗产名录》的东大寺是公元728年遵照重视佛教的圣武天皇圣 旨建造的。东大寺是全国68所国分寺的总寺院,据说是因为建在首都平城京以东,所 以被称作"东大寺"。正面宽度57米、深50米的世界最大的木造建筑东大寺大佛殿内 放置着高15米以上的佛像。
