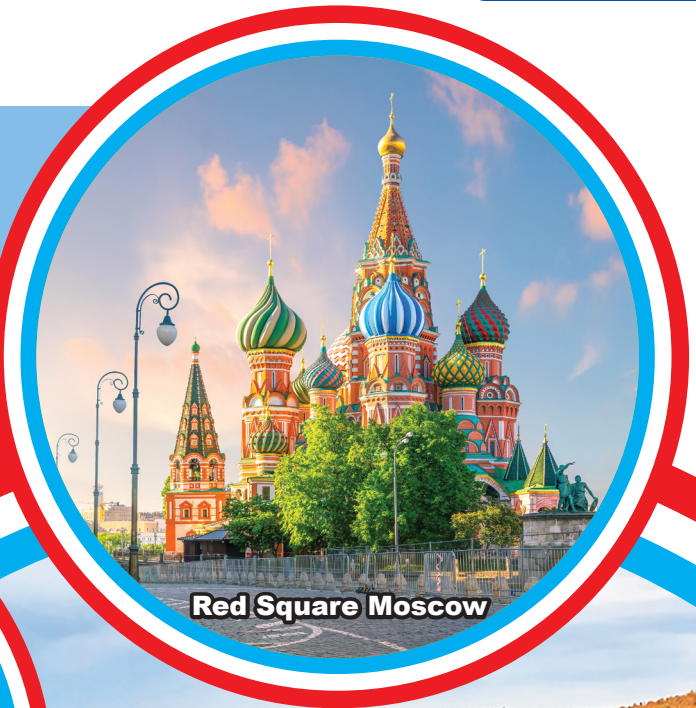

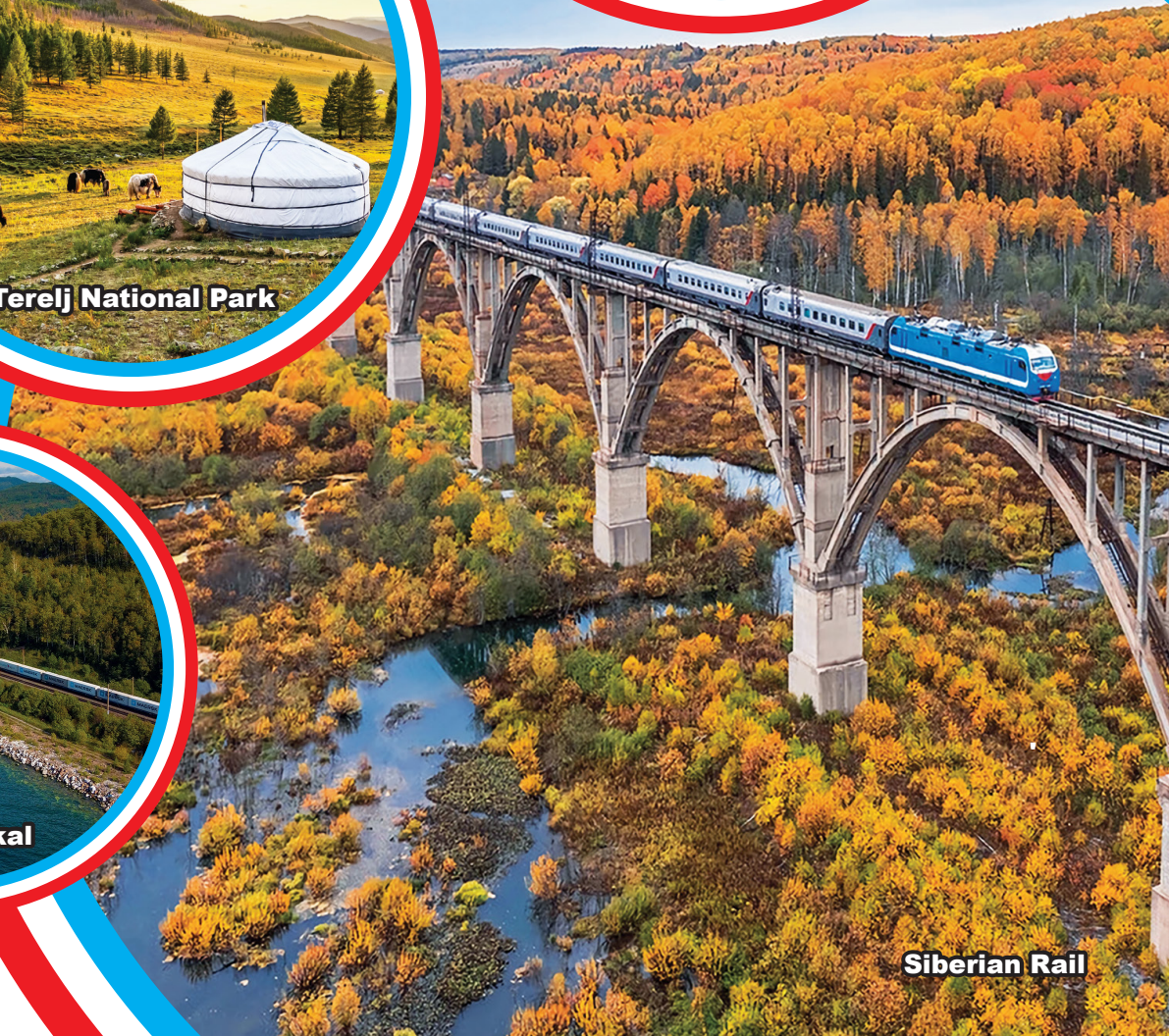

ULAAN BAATAR, MONGOLIA

- **Mongolia** - Is a landlocked country in East Asia, bordered by Russia to the north and China to the south. Ulaan Baatar, the capital and largest city. Mongolia, once the very centre of an enormous empire led by Genghis Khan, is a country rich in culture and history with beautiful landscapes and nomadic people.
- **Terelj National Park** - Renowned for its breathtaking natural beauty. The National Park is known for its outstanding rock formations. Among them, 24 m tall Turtle shaped rock. Surrounded by vast nomadic yurt settlements, showcasing the unique blend of urban and nomadic lifestyles.
- **Gandan Monastery** - One of Mongolia's most important Buddhist Monasteries housing a community of over 500 monks. The full name, Gandantegchinlen, translates as 'the great place of complete joy'.

IRKUTSK, RUSSIA

- **Lake Baikal** - Is the deepest lake (1,620 m) in the world and holds 20 per cent of the world's freshwater. It is home to a unique breed of freshwater seal and over 50 species of fish including omul. Surrounded by majestic mountain ranges and showcasing its deep blue waters. Lake Baikal is frozen from January to May.
- **Taltsy Museum** - The open-air museum Taltsy features wooden buildings brought from all over Siberia. The museum complex is divided into three sectors. One of them is devoted to traditional structures of Buryat people inhabited the Irkutsk territory to the west of the Baikal.
- **St. Nicholas Church** - This wooden church with bell towers was built in the 19th century by a Russian merchant who, it is said, was saved by St. Nicholas while crossing the lake during a terrible storm.
- **Decembrist Museum** - The former residence of Duke Sergei Volkonsky, a Decembrist, was converted into a museum in 1985. It is an elegant gray-blue Russian-style building has two floors and numerous small rooms that contain many of the Volkonsky family's original possessions and items of the era. People from all over the world come to Irkutsk to learn about the destiny of the Volkonsky family who were exiled to Siberia after the Decembrist revolt.

KRASNOYARSK, RUSSIA

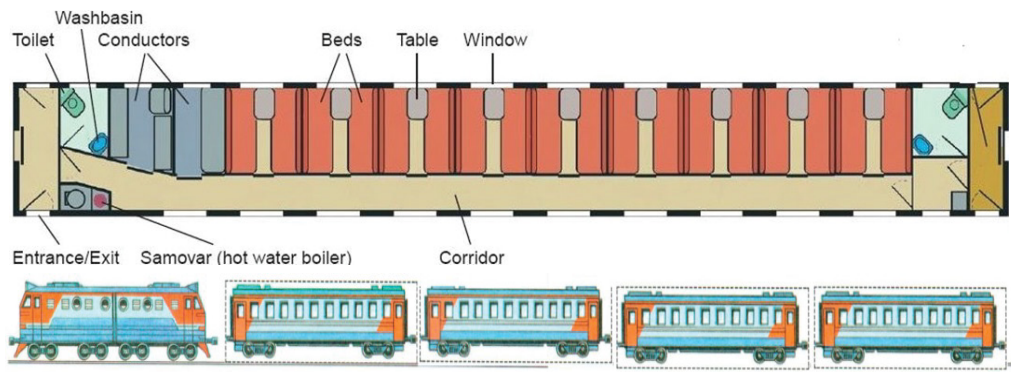
- **Krasnoyarsk** - Is the largest Siberian port on the Yenisei River. The city was founded in 1628 by Russian explorers directed their steps to the Far East.

EKATERINBURG, RUSSIA

- **Cathedral on The Blood** - A place of immense significance in Russian history. This is the place where the Romanov Tsar family was killed in July 1918; after World War II, the former Ipatiev house served for the anti-religion museum. In front of the church, there is a monument to the Romanov family, with spiral stairs symbolizing the stairs in Ipatiev's house and reminding of the last minutes of Tsars' family.
- **Ganina Yama Monastery** - Built in memory of the Romanovs, Russia's last royal family, it was the place where the last Czar's family who found their resting place in Gania Yama. The holy landmark, is among the most significant pilgrimage sights in entire Russia.

KAZAN, RUSSIA

- **Kazan** - Is renowned for its vibrant mix of Tatar and Russian cultures.
- **Kazan Kremlin** - Is the pearl of city and is the ruins of an ornate complex that once served as the main citadel of Tatarstan. The city has a citadel's major monuments in the Kremlin are the five-domed, six-columned Annunciation Cathedral (1561–62) and the mysterious, formerly leaning Söyembikä Tower, named after the last queen of Kazan and regarded as the city's most conspicuous landmark.

MOSCOW, RUSSIA

- **Red Square** - One of the oldest and largest squares in Moscow located in Moscow's historic centre
- **St Basil's Cathedral** - Commonly known as the Cathedral of Vasily the Blessed, it is a church in Red Square. The building now a museum, officially known as the Cathedral of the intercession of the Most Holy Theotokos on the Moat of Pokrovsky Cathedral. It was built from 1556 - 1561 on orders from Ivan the Terrible and commemorates the capture of Kazan and Astrakhan. A world famous landmark, it was the city's tallest building till the completion of the Ivan the Great Bell Tower in 1600.
- **Kremlin** - The word "kremlin" simply means "fortified town". It is a fortified complex at the heart of Moscow. The Moscow Kremlin is one of the largest museums in the world. State regalia, invaluable icons, and treasures of Russian tsars are all stored in the Kremlin chambers and cathedrals. It is the best know of the kremlins (Russian citadels) and includes five palaces, four cathedrals and the enclosing Kremlin Wall with Kremlin towers.
- **Moscow Metro** - With its stations decorated with marble, mosaics, stained glass panels and bronze sculptures looks like a vast art museum.
