## SWEDEN - ABISKO

- **Ice Hotel 365** - is the world's first incredible hotel designed made of ice and snow to be open throughout the year and delivers an ice experience on 2,100 square feet with 20 suites, ice bar and ice gallery – all run-on solar power.
- **Abisko National Park** - is a classic region in the heart of Lapland's alpine world, known for its stunning natural scenery and diverse Nordic wildlife. Majestic mountains frame the beautiful Abiskodalen valley with its flowering alpine meadows, picturesque rapids and Scandinavia's largest alpine lake.

## NORWAY - TROMSO

- **Arctic Cathedral** - is the striking building is impossible to miss across the water from the city centre. It's unique design, it is one of the most famous churches in Norway.
- **Fjellheisen** - is an aerial tramway located in the city of Tromsø, one of the main attractions of the city. Hop on a cable car ride up to mountain Fjellheisen Storsteinen, 420 meters above sea level. At the top there is a point from where you can see a view of the city of Tromsø, waterways and the surrounding mountains, midnight sun and the northern lights.

**Note:** Fjellheisen cable car will stop operate due to heavy snowing and strong winds.

## NORWAY - REINE

- **Hamnøy** - is a picturesque and iconic fishing village located in the Lofoten Islands of Norway. It is situated on the island of Moskenesøya, which is known for its dramatic landscapes, including jagged mountains, fjords, and pristine beaches. Hamnøy is one of the oldest villages in the region and is famous for its traditional red wooden houses, known as "rorbuer," which were originally used by fishermen. These rorbu cabins are now popular for tourists who want to experience the charm and natural beauty of the area. This village is also well-known for its stunning scenery, making it a favorite spot for photographers, particularly with its views of the surrounding mountains and the nearby Reinefjord.

## NORWAY - KIRKENES

- **King Crab Safari + Enjoy "THE BEST OF NORWEGIAN SET LUNCH SEAFOOD"** - A totally unforgettable experience awaits you on the fjords of Kirkenes. This is your chance to eat this mysterious creature. Although presentation is simple, the superb white leg meat and claws, with their particularly juicy and naturally sweet taste, make this meal in a league of its own.

**Note:** You will head out to the fjord either by snowmobile sleigh or boat accompany by experienced staff. They will demonstrate of pulling crab cage & you will have an option to take photograph with King Crab. (subject to weather conditions)

- **Aurora Borealis** - is a beautiful and mysterious natural phenomenon that occurs when solar winds interact with the Earth's magnetic field, causing high-energy electrons and ions to enter the Earth's atmosphere and collide with gas molecules, releasing energy and producing brilliant lights. The best season for the Aurora Borealis is from Sep till Apr with the most frequent sightings occurring between 6pm to 1am.

The opportunity to witness this visual wonder of nature, it is subjected on weather conditions such as solar activity, cloud cover and other factors and cannot be guaranteed. However, sighting is not confined to this schedule as the "dancing green lights" may show up randomly during your stay in Lapland.

**Tour Manager will guide customer where to view the Aurora – it can be surrounding hotel area by walking distance.**

**Note :** Aurora Borealis is a natural phenomenon, Golden Destinations unable to guarantee the appearance of during your visit at anytime.

- **Snow Hotel** - is situated 8km outside Kirkenes in the secluded wilds of Northern Norway since 2006. Dreamlike rooms uniquely carved by master ice sculptors from around the world. Hotel is built completely of snow and ice, and each spring melts back into the fjord. Snowhotel is one of the most famous igloo hotels in Norway, and in the world.

- **Husky Dog Farm** - also known as the Polar husky, is Lapland's most heartfelt friend. Visit the huskies Farm to learn about their daily routines and training. Husky sledding is a truly thrilling and memorable experience.
- **Tankavaara Gold Museum** - is a village and a tourist attraction in the municipality of Sodankylä in Lapland, Finland. Tankavaara is home for the only international museum in the World displaying past and present of gold panning and prospecting. The basic exhibition presents the history of gold prospecting in Lapland.

## FINLAND - ROVANIEMI

- **Santa Claus Village** - is an Amusement Park in Rovaniemi in the Lapland region of Finland. It was opened in 1985. There are many souvenir shops as well as Santa's Main Post Office, programme service companies and cafes and restaurants in the Santa Claus Village. And of course, Santa is there too, in his chamber every day of the year.
- **Santa's Main Post Office** - is a tourist destination in Santa Claus Village in the Arctic Circle. In Santa Claus' Main Post Office visitors can also read letters sent to Santa. A letter writer can arrange to have a letter mailed to them from Santa before Christmas. This special Arctic Circle postmark is a popular collectable and souvenir.
- **Arctic Circle** - It is almost impossible not to cross the Arctic Circle in Rovaniemi, it is a must do activity in Santa Claus Village.
