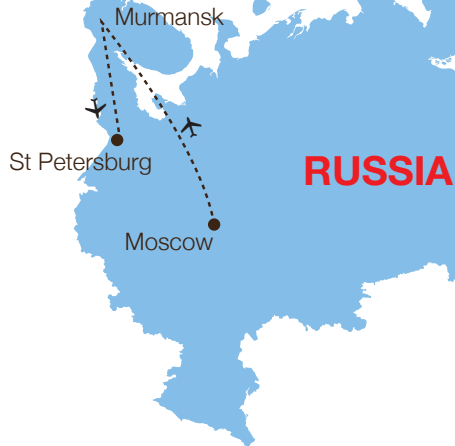

## MOSCOW

- **Red Square** - It is rich in symbols of Russia’s turbulent and intriguing past, it has been for centuries, the heart and soul of Russia. The square’s name it derives from the word ‘krasnyi’, which once meant ‘beautiful’ and has only come to mean ‘red’ in contemporary.
- **St Basil’s Cathedral** - It is an Orthodox church on the Red Square in Moscow. It’s interior and exterior as its architectural style is unique and constitutes the icon of the city. It was built of the Khanate of Kazan and declared as a World Heritage Site by UNESCO in 1990s, along with the entire Kremlin.
- **Kremlin** - The name Kremlin means “fortress inside a city”. It is a fortified complex at the heart of Moscow, overlooking the Moskva River to the south, St Basil’s Cathedral and Red Square to the east and the Alexander Garden to the west. It is the best know of the kremlins (Russian Citadels) and includes five palaces, four cathedrals and the enclosing Kremlin Wall with Kremlin towers.
- **Moscow Metro** - One of the world’s most beautiful subway systems. Famous for its grand Soviet-era architecture, marble halls, chandeliers, and mosaic art. It’s fast, affordable, and connects major attractions across the city, making it both a transport system and an underground museum for travelers.
- **Russian Wooden Doll (Matreshka)** - The iconic Russian nesting doll. Each wooden doll opens to reveal a smaller one inside, often hand-painted with traditional folk designs. Symbolizes family, continuity, and Russian heritage.

## MURMANSK

- **Saami Village** - Dive into the fabulous atmosphere of the Saami World. Here, you will not only to know fascinating and exciting information about the traditional lifestyle of Saami but also get vivid emotions and memories that will forever leave a mark in your heart. You can taste Saami cuisine, feed the reindeer and husky dog, photo session in national Saami costumes, Reindeer and Snowmobile sleigh ride.
- **Museum Nuclear-Powered Icebreaker “Lenin”** - The first surface ship with nuclear propulsion, Icebreaker was built in the Soviet Union, first and foremost to serve the Northern Sea Route. The Icebreaker “Lenin” in 1989 was decommissioned and put on external parking in Murmansk.
- **Teriberka** - An amazing place in the Northern part of the Kola Peninsula. Here you can see firsthand the unfrozen shore of the Arctic ocean, snow-covered endless expanses of the Arctic tundra, a sandy beach in the middle of snowdrifts and the polar sun.

**MURMANSK**

- **Aurora Borealis** - Is a beautiful and mysterious natural phenomenon that occurs when solar winds interact with the Earth's magnetic field, causing high-energy electrons and ions to enter the Earth's atmosphere and collide with gas molecules, releasing energy and producing brilliant lights. The best season for the Aurora Borealis is from Sep till Apr with the most frequent sightings occurring between 6pm to 1am.

The opportunity to witness this visual wonder of nature, it is subjected on weather conditions such as solar activity, cloud cover and other factors and cannot be guaranteed. However, sighting is not confined to this schedule as the "dancing green lights" may show up randomly during your stay in Russia.

**ST PETERSBURG**

- **Peterhof Palace** - Known as the "Russian Versailles", which consists of a series of palaces and gardens that were the residence of the czars. The beautiful Peterhof Palace is a series of palaces and gardens just outside of town, majestic and covered in gold, is often referred to as the "Russian Versailles". Golden Grand Cascade, a steep fall of 64 gilded fountains flowing in front of the Grand Palace.
- **Church of Savior on the Spilled Blood** - Also known as Cathedral of the Resurrection of Christ. Construction began in 1883 during the reign of Alexander III, 2 years after the assassination of his father Alexander. The avior on Blood harks back to medieval Russian architecture in the spirit of romantic nationalism.
- **The Peter and Paul Fortress** - It is the original citadel of St Petersburg, Russia, founded by Peter the Great in 1703 and built to Domenico Trezzini's designs from 1706 to 1740. In the early 1920s, it was still used as a prison and execution ground by the bolshevik government. Today it has been adapted as the central and the most important part of the State Museum of Saint Petersburg history. The museum has gradually become virtually the sole owner of the fortress building, except the structure occupied by the Saint Petersburg Mint.








